



Coach Criteria

To become a coach as part of the KSS LC Coaching Hub applicants must fulfil the following criteria:

Criteria	Yes/No
Have successfully completed a recognised accredited coach training programme (EMCC/ILM) to a minimum of level 5.	
Have a well maintained learning log and portfolio of evidence for their coaching, including certificates of accredited qualification(s) which should be provided on registering.	
Have evidence of CPD and supervision within the last 2 years or demonstrate willingness to attend a minimum of two CPD and two supervision sessions each year.	
Have experience of being coached as well as coaching others.	

KSS Leadership Academy asks Coaches to commit to:

- Three coaching relationships of 4-6 sessions each year (This is on the proviso that the coach is requested)
- Attend two supervision sessions a year (these can be individual or group)
- Attend two CPD events a year commissioned by KSS Leadership Academy or provided by other recognised professional organisations.
- Be willing to provide evaluation where necessary to support wider coaching evaluation projects.
